

Flower Garden Gift Bag

Need to wrap a special Spring gift?
Create your own decorative bag!

This idea works great if your gift is a special plant or flower, but is delightful for any gift!

Supplies:

- Plain brown bag
- One or two packages of flower seeds
- Garden catalog or magazine with floral pictures
- Glue stick or tacky glue
- Scissors, decorative edge if you have them
- Ribbon or raffia
- Paper hole punch
- Rubber cement (optional)

1. Cut out some pretty flower pictures from the garden catalog or magazine.
2. Glue these all over the bag. (Let dry)
3. Glue on a couple of seed packages using a small "blob" of rubber cement on the back of the seed packs, let dry.
4. After the rubber cement is dry, stick the package onto the bag. The rubber cement will allow the seed packages to be easily removed.
5. You could also glue real seeds on your bag!
6. Attach the ribbon by punching 2 holes in the top of the bag and 2 holes in the top of the seed packet.
7. String your ribbon through the holes so both ends come out through the front of the bag. Tie your ribbon.
8. Make a matching note card using an extra picture.
9. Cut a card-size rectangle of brown paper and fold in half.
10. Glue a pretty flower to the front of the card.
