

## Silly Jar Gifts

Beef Chili, Chicken Noodle Soup, Donut Seeds  
...plus 100% Natural Bubble Bath

Use baby food jars or similar small jars for these silly jar gifts. Glue the lids onto the jars, which have water inside. Painting the lids is optional. If not painting the lid, add a fabric circle to cover the lid. Create a tag and attach it the jar with raffia or ribbon.

### Beef Chili

- Place a small cow in the jar and add some dry beans.
- Label "Beef Chili"

### Chicken Noodle Soup

- Place a small chicken in the jar.
- Add some egg noodles.
- Label "Chicken Noodle Soup"

### Donut Seeds

- Fill with Cheerios cereal.
- Label "Donut Seeds". Or fill with Frosted Cheerios.
- Label "Powdered Donut Seeds".

### Been Fishing Lately?

- Decorate the outside of a clean empty jar with fish stickers.
- Add few small shells.
- Fill the jar about three-fourths full with water, and finish filling with light corn syrup.
- Add a couple of drops of blue food color and some blue glitter. Seal the lid to the jar to prevent leaking.

### Instant Ocean

- Fill jar halfway with water and add a few drops of blue food coloring.
- Fill with mineral or cooking oil.
- Seal the lid to the jar to prevent leaking.

### Pork 'N' Beans

- Place a small pig in the jar.
- Add some dry beans to the jar.
- I received one of these as a gift.
- The crafter used pantyhose to make a soft-sculpture pig face and tail end.
- The beans were added around it and the pig's face and tail end was squashed up against each side of the jar.

### 100% Natural Bubble Bath

- Fill the jar with dried beans.
- Label "100% Natural Bubble Bath."
- Add these directions to the tag: "Cook beans, ingest at least one hour before bathing."
